NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES AND OTHER RACE CONDITIONS

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and other rules and conditions as defined in the Notices of Race from the yacht clubs that are the Organizing Authority of the individual regattas that comprise this 2010 J/120 Fleet Four Southern California High Point Series.
- 1.2** The J/120 Class Association Rules and the J/120 Southern California Fleet Four Local Amendments will also govern.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1** The regatta is open to all J/120s whose owners are members in good standing of J/120 Southern California Fleet Four, or, if from outside the area of Fleet Four, are members in good standing of their local fleet or the national class.
- 2.2** Eligible boats may enter by completing the forms for each individual regatta that is a part of this 2010 J/120 Fleet Four Southern California High Point Series. All eligible yachts that compete in any regatta of this 2010 J/120 Fleet Four Southern California High Point Series are deemed to be entered in the 2010 J/120 Fleet Four Southern California High Point Series.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be provided by the yacht club that is the Organizing Authority for each regatta.

5 SCORING

Scoring for the 2010 J/120 Southern California Fleet Four High Point Series shall be per the "Low Point Scoring System" per the Racing Rules of Sailing current revision as published by US Sailing. Each yacht's overall score for each regatta will count as one score for the 2010 J/120 Fleet Four Southern California High Point Series. If non-eligible yachts are scored by the Organizing Authority of the individual regattas, those yachts finishes will be ignored and eligible yacht's scores following the ineligible yachts will be advanced. One score will be thrown out for 2010 J/120 Fleet Four Southern California High Point Series scoring.

6 PRIZES

The winning yacht's and owner's names will be engraved on the J/120 Fleet Four Southern California High Point Series perpetual trophy which will be prominently displayed at the winning owner's yacht club. Individual take-home trophies may be awarded.
